Little Nursery Afternoon children

Following on from our letter yesterday, I write this morning to further update you.

Due to the availability of staff over the next few weeks, the Governing Body has had to further consider the School's Risk Assessment. As a result of this review the School will need to further alter the number of pupils who can attend the School site.

The afternoon session in Little Nursery will only therefore be open in the first instance over the next few weeks for pupils of keyworkers and vulnerable pupils. Where there are additional places available, priority will be given to families where both parents are at work during Nursery School hours and are dependent upon the place to attend work. What happens after this date will then be reviewed.

Our induction drop-in session will continue as normal today, and following this, the Nursery School will be in contact with you over the next couple of days.

If your job role means that you are a keyworker (critical worker) and would therefore seek to have a place for your child in Little Nursery, could you please email parents1041@welearn365.com saying what your keyworker role is and a member of the Nursery team will get back to you.
