

# Daily Activity 08.01.21



## Ice Play

1. Help your child to find items to trap in the ice. These can be natural items from the garden or small plastic toys



2. Use any freezer safe containers (yogurt pots work well for this). Add your items to the containers and cover with water

3. Discuss how ice is made? Ask your child if they know, maybe pretend you've forgotten how. Children love to show you how much they know.

4. Place the containers in the freezer. Explain it may take some time for the water to change



5. Once frozen, explore the ice with your child. Ask questions such as; how does it feel and what happened to the items in the water? Allow your child to observe the ice as it melts. Discuss with them why the ice is melting
