## Create your own Butterfly!

## What you need:

- Paper/card
- Marker pen
- Tissue paper/paint/felt-tip pens
- Scissors

## How to make your butterfly

- 1. Fold a piece of paper/card in half, encourage your child to help you do this.
- 2. Adult to draw half of the butterfly like the image on the right using the marker pen.
- 3. Keeping the card folded adult to cut out the butterfly.
- 4. Let your child open the card to reveal a butterfly.
- 5. Let your child decorate the butterfly.
