School Closure

Thank you to our families and staff for supporting the Nursery School to continue with business as usual up until now during the escalating situation regarding Coronavirus.

However the picture locally and nationally is becoming increasingly difficult to manage as illness and self-isolation begins to impact so many.

Following the Coronavirus update by the Prime Minister yesterday, we will be closing our doors at the end of the school day tomorrow, **Friday 20th March**. The Nursery School will be working closely with the Local Authority and the DFE to support children of key workers and vulnerable children with childcare provision. Examples of these workers may include NHS staff, police and delivery drivers. Vulnerable children may include those who have Educational Social Workers and those with Education, Health and Care Plans.

We are currently awaiting details of a standardised list of key worker categories and also those children who are classed as vulnerable. Details of provision will then be shared once they have been finalised. Children who do not fall into these categories should remain at home with appropriate care.

On behalf of the Governors and staff of the Nursery School, may I wish you all well in the coming weeks and months and I look forward to welcoming you all back to Nursery School again in due course. In the meantime, I hope that you and your families keep safe and healthy in these uncertain times.
