Dear Parents/Carers

### Children who are feeling unwell

We are currently seeing a number of children who are not feeling well for a variety of reasons and are displaying a range of different symptoms, including a high temperature.

When considering the current rise in rates of the COVID-19 Delta variant and being mindful of our COVID Workplace Risk Assessment, could we please remind parents and carers:

- **To not send your child to either Big or Little Nursery if they are at all unwell.**
- **If your child presents with any of the classic COVID-19 symptoms (a high temperature, continuous cough or a change/loss of taste or smell,) please book a PCR test for your child and your household and inform us of the results, or self-isolate with your child for 10 days.**
- **Postal PCR COVID tests are available for your Nursery School child, please ask at reception and let us know your child's result.**
- **To be aware that COVID-19 can present differently in children (please see flow chart below).**

If a child presents as unwell at all during session, staff will contact you and ask for you to collect your child.
