Dear Parents/Carers

Outbreak Management Plan

The Senior Leadership Team have reviewed the activation of the Outbreak Management Plan that was put in place following the positive cases of COVID-19 in Little Nursery. After considering the level of risk, it was decided that the Nursery School would no longer need to work in separate bubbles.

However, taking into account the advice from Public Health England in Warwickshire and also the Government guidance following identification of the new variant Omicron, the following will remain in place until the end of term (Friday 17th December):

- Face coverings will continue to be worn by staff in shared areas.
- **Parents are requested to wear face coverings** whilst they are onsite, unless they are medically exempt.
- Advice and Guidance from Public Health England – Warwickshire will be continued to be adhered to.
- We will limit the number of visitors that need to come into Nursery School.

As we continue to follow guidance for the Nursery School from Public Health England, please remember the following:

- Children who are unwell with **any symptoms of any illness** must not come to Nursery until they have **been well for 48 hours** (2 days). Parents may be advised to take their child for a PCR test.
- **Children who are unwell with any symptoms of any illness in Nursery will be sent home** and parents/carers may be advised to take their child for a PCR test. Children will need to be well for 48 hours (2 days) before they can come to Nursery
- Children displaying the main symptoms of COVID-19, **cough, temperature or loss of smell or taste, should be taken for a PCR test**. Should parents/carers not wish to do this, their children must self-isolate for 10 days.

- Children who have had a negative PCR test must still remain at home until they have been well for 48 hours (2 days).
