Review of the Outbreak Management Plan

Following a review of our Outbreak Management Plan, the Senior Leadership Team have agreed that we are able to step down from our Outbreak Management Plan mitigations at this point.

- The Nursery classes will resume as one bubble.
- Visitors to Nursery will be allowed if their purpose is to maintain the building or support children with their learning.

The following mitigations however will remain:

- We ask that only one parent/carer drops off and collects their child to minimise the number of adults on site at any one time.
- Parents/carers are requested to wear face coverings when onsite indoors and we would advise the use of a face covering for outdoors as well, unless medically exempt.

Although there has not been any update to the national definition of COVID-19 symptoms (cough, high temperature, loss/change in taste/smell), as COVID-19 has been circulating in the school please also be mindful of the wider symptoms of COVID-19 which are sore throat, headache, fatigue, muscle aches, blocked/runny nose, shortness of breath, diarrhoea and vomiting, and cold-like symptoms. Anyone with COVID-19 symptoms should isolate and book a PCR test.

Our procedures will be reviewed on **Wednesday 26th January**, when the Government will review the Plan B regulations, which are currently in place.
