Updated Guidance for Early Years Settings

Dear Parents/Carers

As you may be aware, the Government recently released further guidelines as to what they see as the next steps in recovery planning from the impact of COVID-19. Their guidance states:

'We are also asking nurseries and other early years providers, including childminders, to begin welcoming back all children from week commencing June 1st 2020.'

This is providing the risk assessment in place for each school mitigates risks, and the Government say the 5 main tests are seen to be effective:

- To make sure the NHS can cope by providing sufficient critical care across the UK
- To see a sustained and consistent fall in daily death rates with confidence the UK is beyond the peak
- Reliable data to show the infection rate is falling to manageable levels
- There is enough testing and personal protective equipment (PPE) to meet future demand
- Any changes in restrictions would not lead to a second peak

Staff and Governors are currently thinking in great detail as to what this may mean for the families of the Nursery School. Health and Safety of all remains our paramount concern, and will ultimately determine what provision we can safely provide. I shall be sending you a text link to a survey in the next couple of days to ask you your thoughts so that we may include these into our future planning.
